Operate heavy machinery such as cranes, forklifts, dozers and excavators.



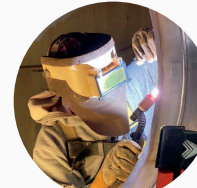
PAINTERS

Work with plasters & concrete materials.



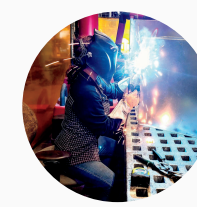
PLUMBERS & PIPEFITTERS
